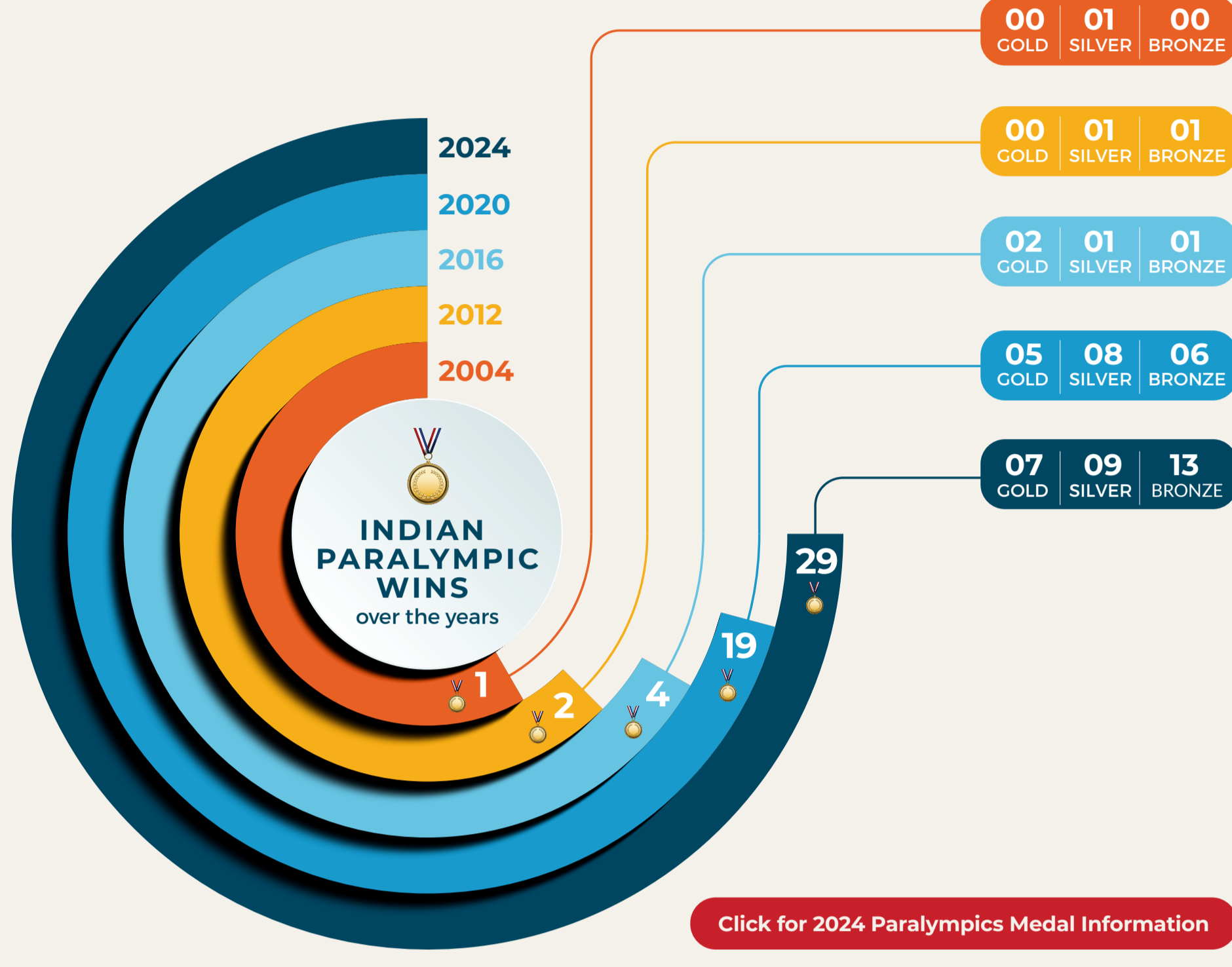
India's Historic Triumph at the Paris Paralympics 2024

India has delivered its best-ever performance at the Paris Paralympics 2024, securing 29 medals: 7 gold, 9 silver, and 13 bronze.

Reflecting on past results, India had 31 medals from 1968 to 2020, with 19 coming from Tokyo 2020 alone. The Paris 2024 campaign has not only set a new record but also demonstrated the extraordinary talent and determination of our athletes. The 2024 Paralympics have been celebrated as the "GREATEST 11 days in the history of Indian Sports."

Luv Kothari

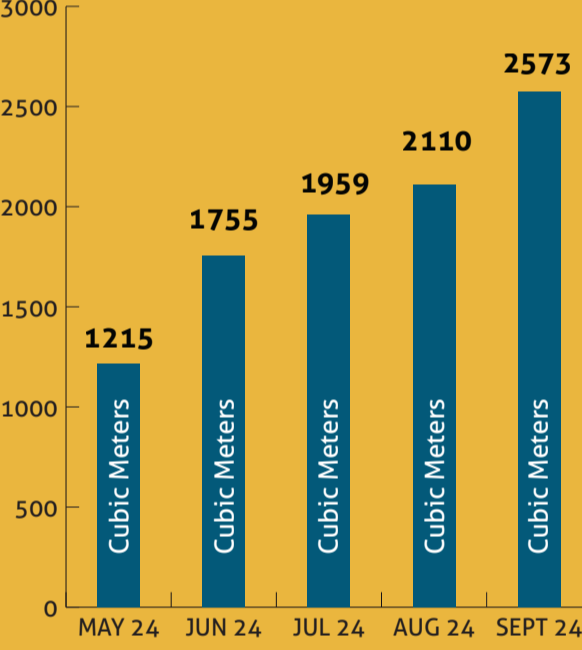

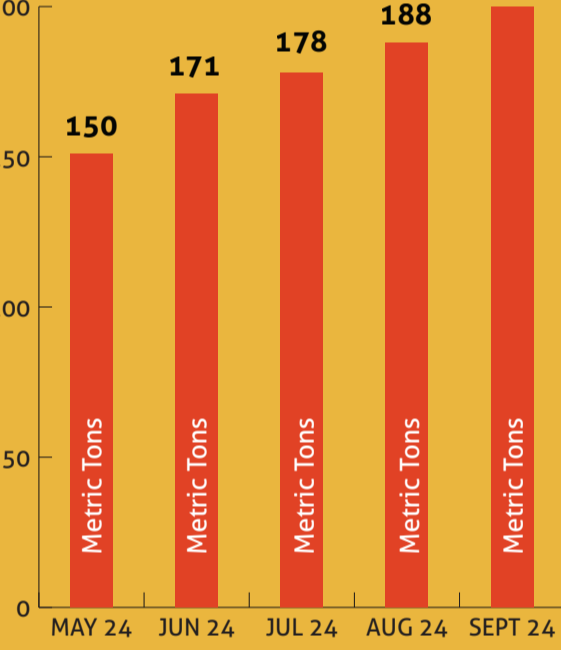

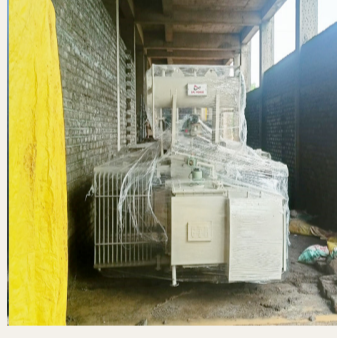
