Facility Updates

Judo Training Area

This month, we launched our **Judo Training Zone**, a key part of our **Phase 1** combat sports expansion. With high-quality tatami mats and safety padding in key areas, we've created a space that prioritizes both performance and athlete safety. Designed for smooth movement and optimal coaching, this zone is built to elevate our judo program to the next level.

Taekwondo Dojang

Adjacent to the judo zone, the **Taekwondo Dojang** now completes our martial arts hub. Equipped with federation-approved flooring, mirrors, and kicking equipment, it's another step towards our "36 mein 36" initiative, adding a new Olympic sport to our high-performance pipeline.

Grassroots Outreach – Local School Visits

This month saw strong momentum in our **School Outreach Program**, covering **7** schools across the Lonavala-Khopoli belt.
